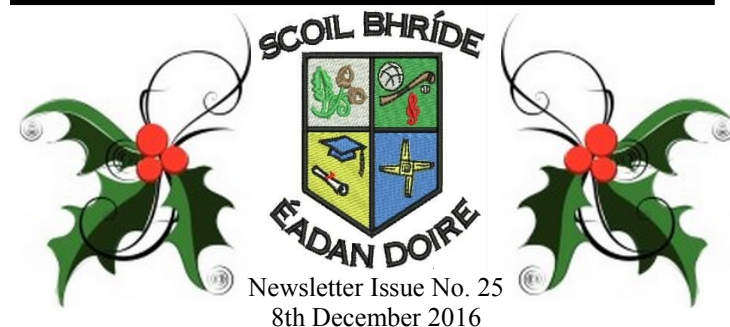
## ARRANGEMENTS FOR SCHOOL BASED CHRISTMAS PERFORMANCES
