MEETING TEACHERS

We would like to remind parents that they should feel free to talk to their child's teacher at any time during the school year. As is stated in our policy and in the interest of ensuring the safety of all pupils in the teacher's class, such meetings should be arranged **by appointment only**. TRAFFIC MOVEMENT AND MANAGEMENT

In accordance with the Terms and Conditions of our Planning Permission for the recent extension to our prefab building, parents/ guardians are advised that there must be strict adherence to the entry and exit procedures when using the car park. All are advised to enter only by the Entrance gate i.e. the gate adjacent to the school building and to exit only by the Exit gate i.e. the gate furthest from the school building. Parents/Guardians are advised that parking on the main road outside of the school is not permitted by law as there are double yellow lines. Your co-operation with this matter is greatly appreciated in the interest of the safety of all children and public using the car park and in ensuring our compliance with our planning permission.
