We have a new online resource for every student in the school!! https://www.myon.co.uk/login/index.html
By now, all students should have received their username and password from their class teacher. This Digital Library is available to students anytime, anywhere, even throughout the holidays, as long as they have a device with an internet browser. There are thousands of exciting books available all the time. There is a high proportion of non-fiction (information) books, also short fiction books, graphic novels and a selection of challenging classic fiction. The information books cover a very wide range of interests, useful for 'just interested' or for project work assigned by their teacher.

A huge benefit is that myOn uses our students most recent ZPD (Accelerated Reader reading range) and will recommend books to them according to their interests and within their reading ability range. It will also prompt them to take a quiz to check their understanding.

MyON is multi-functioning: many of the books have audio so that students can listen while they follow the text, then can enlarge the pages, use dictionary tools, make notes in their own journal, and create their own reading lists. MyON remembers the last book they read, and where they got to. It also tells students how much time they have spent reading and how many pages they have read in the session. Students can even download up to twenty books to read offline.

We are so lucky to have access to this amazing resource. Happy reading!!!!!!!

CHILD PROTECTION INSPECTION

On the 13th and 14th of October 2020, two inspectors from the Department of Education and Skills visited our school for a follow-up *Child Protection and Safe-guarding Inspection*. Our initial inspection was conducted shortly before the school closed in March 2020. The inspectors looked at all of our plans, policies and procedures relating to Child Protection. They also interviewed staff, and conducted focus groups with some children from each class level. The inspectors were highly complimentary of the school and the measures we have put in place to keep our children safe. We were deemed to be "Fully Compliant" with all Child Protection requirements.
