CHILD SAFEGUARDING INFOR-MATION

Please read and familiarise yourself with the information below regarding Scoil Bhríde's child safeguarding procedures.

The Board of Management is responsible for the implementation of all provisions of the Children First Act 2015. The Board of Management recognises that child protection and welfare considerations permeate all aspects of school life and must as a result be reflected in the schools policies, procedures, practices and activities. The child safeguarding statement is available to view on our website or on the wall inside the front door of the school. The schools Designated Liason Person (DLP) is Mr. Duffy and the Deputy DLP is Ms. Rourke. The DLP, and in his absence the Deputy DLP, are the first point of contact you make should you have a concern regarding the welfare of any student within the school. It is the responsibility of the DLP to ensure reporting procedures are followed correctly and promptly and act as a liaison person with other agencies.

REDESIGNATION OF PRESCHOOL EARLY INTERVENTION CLASS TO PRIMARY AGED SPECIAL CLASS.

As advised by the NCSE and with subsequent approval from the Board of Management, the school has begun the process of redesignating the Preschool/Early Intervention class into a 6th Primary Aged Special Class. The school will not accept enrolment applications for the Preschool/Early Intervention class from September 2022 onwards.
