

Our teachers received training for this new curriculum in the last academic year and will receive further training in 2025. We hope that these changes will bring about a more positive experience of maths for the children at Scoil Bhríde.

# Literacy Updates

Some of our local librarians from Edenderry Library visited our Junior Infant classes this month. All the children enjoyed their story time sessions.

First and Second Class pupils took a trip to Edenderry Library. They participated in a scavenger hunt and enjoyed a story in the library.

Fifth Class pupils participated in Creative Writing Workshops with Offaly Fighting Words and wrote their own story called 'The Wonky Christmas'. They are looking forward to sharing their story with the rest of the school. Mr Brereton's 6<sup>th</sup> Class completed the last chapter of their book with the Offaly Fighting Words team. They were presented with a printed copy of their story.

Some of our Fifth Class pupils have started our first school book club and meet every Friday in our school library.

Children's author Shane Hegarty will be visiting our school on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of January. Shane will complete two workshops with the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> classes. Shane is the author of many bestselling series including 'Boot' and 'Darkmouth'. 'Boot' was nominated for the Sainsbury's Children's Book Prize and the An Post Irish Book of the Year.
