
Update to School Uniform

There are exciting times ahead for Scoil Bhríde as we begin to roll out our new school uniform for September 2024. The introduction of the new tracksuit will take place on a phased basis with a requirement for all incoming Junior Infants to wear the new uniform and purchase of the new uniform optional for all other students (Senior Infants to 6th class).

The new school uniform will be available for purchase in both Dermot Halls Menswear and Anna-Marie Boutique for a cost of €45. (this includes a crested half zip top and crested tracksuit bottoms).

In order to reduce costs for families, the option to wear the new and existing uniform will be accepted for the duration of the 2024/2025 school year.

Please note that if children are wearing the "old" school uniform next year they must wear plain black tracksuit bottoms – leggings and branded tracksuit bottoms will not be accepted.
